### Ash Wednesday - February 14, 2024



Lent is the Christian season of spiritual preparation before Easter. For us it begins on Ash Wednesday with the imposition of ashes. During Lent, many Christians observe a period of fasting, repentance, moderation, self-denial, and/or spiritual discipline. The intent of the Lenten season is reflection on Jesus Christ; with intentional time set aside to consider his suffering, sacrifice, life, death, burial, and resurrection, which offers us hope in life and death.








### Event Highlights: Italian Dinner

### Finance Committee

### FINANCE UPDATE -DECEMBER 2023

The Finance Committee continues to monitor Jerusalem's financial situation and giving as reflected in our monthly reports.

Current Income for the month of December was \$36,932 and Current Expenses were \$31,203 which was a surplus of \$5,729.

Current Income for the year to date was \$230,478 and Current Expenses were \$313,731 for a shortfall of \$83,253.

Total Income for the month of December was \$60,480 and Total Expenses were \$53,664 for a surplus of \$6,816.

Total Income for the year to date was \$276,183 and Total Expenses were \$399,171 for a shortfall of \$122,988. An important note. The income figures for December are subject to change since it is not unusual for additional contributions to be received at the beginning of the year that are actually made in 2023.

Attendance for the month of December was 516, an increase of 65 from December 2022 although there was one more Sunday in 2023. Year to date attendance was 4,284, an increase of 794 from the total of 3,490 in 2022.

We have liquidated \$83,253 from the Foundation Fund and \$43,000 from the Building Fund. It is important to note that the more that is liquidated from the reserve accounts, the less income that these reserves will generate!
